Joseph Preston Caldwell II, a resident of Okmulgee County died on Thursday, January 27, 2011. Joe was born in Brompton, Alabama on March 7, 1925 to Joseph Preston and Fannie Bell (Bowlin) Caldwell. He was a veteran of the U.S. Army and was awarded several medals including the Purple Heart. He was a member of the Trinity Baptist Church in Morris and was well known as an independent oil producer. His parents, a son Samuel Houston Caldwell preceded him in death.
