



Judge Anne Elizabeth Moroney

November 1, 1908 - June 27, 2010

“Judge Anne” Elizabeth Moroney, 101, died in Okmulgee on Sunday, June 27, 2010. She was born in Okmulgee on November 1, 1908 to James J. and Mary Boland Moroney. She was educated in the Okmulgee Schools and graduated from St. Theresa’s College, Winnana, MN. After working as a teacher and then for the Phillips Oil Company she graduated from the University of Tulsa School of Law in 1946. She practiced law in Tulsa and Okmulgee and was co-owner of Walco Larraine Company in Okmulgee.

In 1971, Governor David Hall appointed her Special Judge for Okmulgee County. She was promoted to Associate Judge in the Okmulgee District in 1978. The appointment came from Gov. George Nigh. She was elected District Judge in 1986 and served until her retirement in 1994. While on the bench she was responsible for the establishment of the Youth Shelter which bears her name. She has always been active in her church St. Anthony’s Catholic Church and the Diocese of Tulsa. She was a member of the Knights and Ladies of the Equestrian Order of the Holy Sepulchre of Jerusalem. Her parents, five brothers and numerous other relatives preceded her in death. Survivors include nieces and nephews; Edward F. Moroney and Joyce of Vian, OK, James J.
