June Parker, loving Wife, Mother, Grandma, Great Grandma and dedicated teacher, passed away at her home surrounded by family and friends on April 24, 2018. She was born in Morris, OK on February 17, 1936 to Jake and Leota Reynolds. June was raised in the First Christian Church of Morris and graduated from Morris High School in 1954. While in school she met the love of her life Charley Parker and they were married on June 20, 1954 at the Patti Anne Café in Henryetta, OK by Brother George Boston.

June and Charley moved to Fairfax, OK in 1955 where they raised their four children. In 1979 June fulfilled her lifelong dream and became a Teacher and Theatre Director at Fairfax High School where she taught for 29 years. After retiring June and Charley returned to Morris where she spent the remainder of her life.

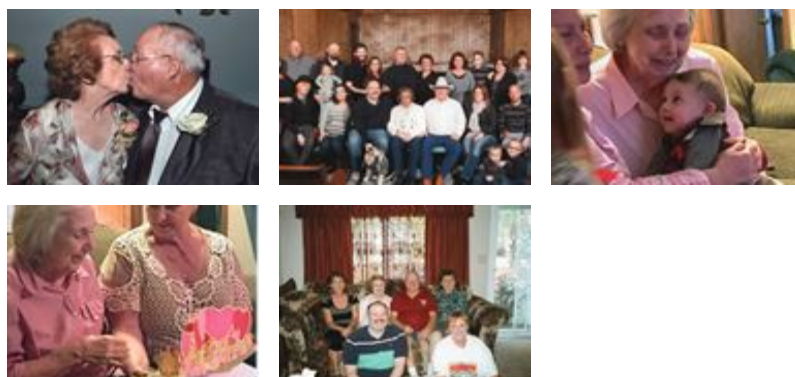
