Kathryn Coleman Lovett was born to Dwight L and Gladys Haygood Coleman (who preceded her in death) on September 23, 1948. An Oklahoma native, she attended Attucks, Banneker Public Schools and graduated from historic Dunbar High School. She attended West Virginia State College where she became a Member of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority Alpha Delta Chapter, transferred to Atlanta, graduated from HBCU Morris Brown College with a Bachelors of Science Degree in Secretarial Science Education.

Making Atlanta home, she became a Senior Secretary Specialist with IBM, a Customer Contact Associate with ATT and following her passion for music, a position with the Atlanta Symphony.

One her most treasured accomplishments was chartering the East Point College Park Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta for which she was President Emeritus. Returning to her Oklahoma roots, she began working at Okmulgee High School. Became very involved with Okmulgee youth providing wisdom and encouragement. Loved her community and mentoring Breast Cancer Survivors. Kathryn was baptized and confirmed into the catholic church. She was a member of the Uganda Martyrs Catholic Church and served as a lector and an alter server proudly.

Kathryn is survived by her son Brandon and wife Lori of Layton, UT., grandchildren Anastasia, Madolynn, Brayden, Kierra and Quincey, great-grandson Arthur of Layton, UT, and sister Georgia Perkins of Atlanta, GA. A celebration of life service for Kathryn will be held Saturday May 5, 2018 at
