Katie Belle (Williams) Harvey passed away Thursday evening, June 28, 2012 in Wilburton, Oklahoma at 95 years of age. Katie was born on January 27, 1917 in Lamar, Arkansas to Timothy and Ethel (Metcalf) Williams. Her family moved to Beggs in 1931 from Lamar to become cotton farmers. She met Ralph Darrell Harvey and they married August 20, 1938 at the First Baptist Church of Beggs. They owned and operated Harvey's Hardware Store for many years and Katie was a homemaker. Katie had been an active member of the Beggs Chapter of the Order of the Eastern Star, Home Demonstration Club and the Crossroads Baptist Church. Katie and Ralph were married 71 years when he passed away May 12, 2009. She was also preceded in death by her parents, brothers, Joe, Clarence, Ervin, and Roddy Williams, sisters, Earle Reed and Juanita Myles and a grandson, Bart Tyler Harvey.
