Kevin Mark Brown, a resident of Morris, Oklahoma, passed away on Monday, May 17, 2011 in Okmulgee, Oklahoma. He was born on August 2, 1959 in Okmulgee to Wanda and the late Glenn Brown. On May 23, 1985 he married Cindy Thomas in Tulsa, Oklahoma.

Kevin truly loved life and believed in God and staying active. As a teenager he went to work for the Okmulgee Cemetery later going on to work at Kelco until retiring in the spring of 2004 due to medical reasons. His love for life expressed itself in doing the things that brought him joy, such as playing softball with lifelong friends when he was able, raising cattle, hunting, fishing, traveling and recently going to NASCAR races.
