



## Kimberly Renee Wittman

July 12, 1961 - February 13, 2022

Kimberly Renee (Chisholm) Wittman was born Wednesday, July 12, 1961, in Okmulgee to the late Bill and Sue (Hawkins) Chisholm. She passed away Sunday, February 13, 2022, in Tulsa at sixty years of age.

Kim graduated from Wilson High School in 1979. She was employed at American Exchange Bank for many years and later was the Office Manager for the Child Support Division at Muscogee (Creek) Nation. 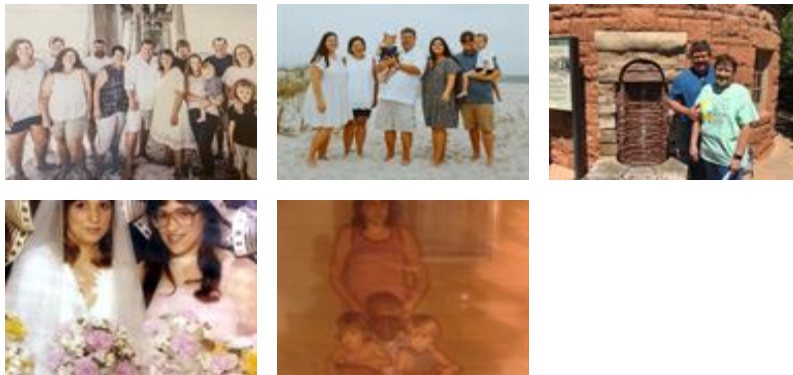

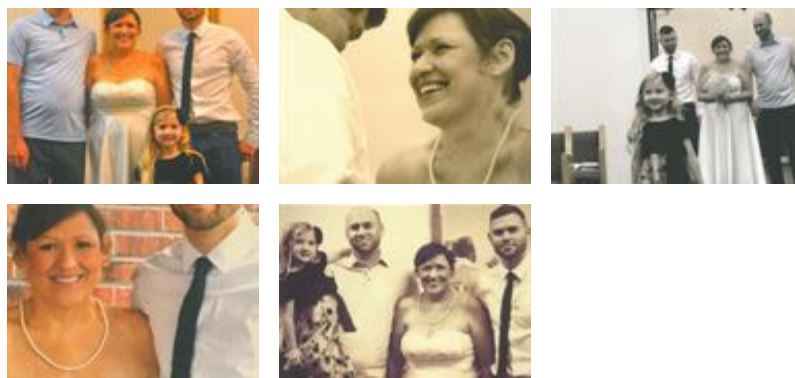
