Kiowa D. Paden, longtime resident of Beggs, passed away Wednesday, January 14, 2015 at his home. He was 93 years of age. Kiowa was born December 14, 1921 in Marble City, Oklahoma to the late Thomas and Gertrude Paden. He moved to Beggs at the age of fourteen and later married Ella Mae Cockrum. Kiowa drove a Beggs School Bus during the 1960's and he built and operated the Beggs Drive-In for several years. He had also owned and operated a grocery store. Kiowa enjoyed watching baseball and spending time working in his yard, but most of all, he loved his family. He was preceded in death by his parents, four brothers and three sisters. Survivors include a son, Sam Paden and wife Sharon of Beggs, two daughters, Tommie Kula and husband Rick of Broken Arrow and Jerrie Griffin and husband Roy of Beggs, seven grandchildren and seventeen great grandchildren. He is also survived by a host of nieces, nephews and longtime friends. A graveside service will be held 2:00 P.M. Friday, January 16, 2015 at the Beggs Cemetery with Pastor Johnny Boyce officiating.
