Kurt Eugene Acton died in Okmulgee on Wednesday, August 12, 2009. He was 52 years old. Kurt was born on November 26, 1956 in Okmulgee to James Kenneth and Pamela (Coker) Acton. Kurt graduated from Okmulgee High School in 1975 and from Oklahoma State University in 1979. He worked as an employment recruiter for Star Training.

His father, James Kenneth Acton and one brother, Kenny Acton preceded him in death.

Kurt is survived by his mother Pamela Acton and four sisters; Denise Stanley and husband John, Jennifer Byassee, Jackie White and husband David, and Diana Peeler, all from Okmulgee. He is also survived by six nephews, three nieces; Jessica Acton, Amy Peeler, and Nicole Graffman, three great nephews; Brodie Lane Graffman, Boston Lee Graffman, and Tucker Mike King and many many friends.

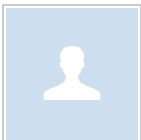


“ Dear Ms. Acton and your family,
