Larry G. Kane, long-time Okmulgee County resident passed away on January 24, 2024, at the age of 70, after a long battle with cancer. He was born in Okmulgee, OK on April 2, 1953, to Gordon and Mary Ann (Checote) Kane.

Larry was an avid outdoors man. He was a lover of duck hunting and fishing for catfish with the grandkids. He farmed and ranched. He enjoyed taking care of his cattle.
