Larry D. Neal passed away after a lengthy illness, at home, with his wife Teresa at his side on February 16, 2025, at the age of 78. Larry was born on February 5th, 1947 in Okmulgee to Lowell and Doris Neal.

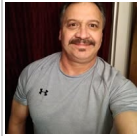
