Lauren Elizabeth Hess was born Wednesday, March 26, 1980 in Oklahoma City, Okla to Debbie (Dixon) and Randy Hess. She left us far too soon on Sunday, September 6, 2020 at her home in Tulsa from complications of juvenile (Type 1) diabetes.

Lauren was raised in Okmulgee, Okla and graduated from Okmulgee High School, class of 1998. She attended the University of Oklahoma where she pledged Pi Beta Phi and graduated with a B.A. in Liberal Studies.

Lauren was a force. She captivated and commanded a room with her contagious smile, roaring laughter and animated stories. She was smart and quick witted. She excelled in sports, going to State in both tennis and golf, and was thrilled when she made her hole in one. She was a skilled gardener and found purpose in arranging flowers and landscape design. Lauren was creative and brought joy to others through planning and hosting parties and events. She loved being surrounded by family and friends, decorating for the holidays, the lake, traveling, her time in Boston, singing and dancing, and a good book.

She was fiercely protective of her family, even giving herself the title of “bodyguard” to her younger sister and nephews. Lauren was a loyal friend, putting everyone above herself until her last day.

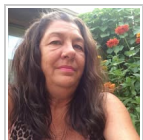

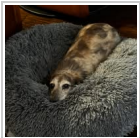

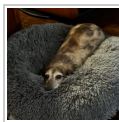
