Leland Wayne Chambers, longtime Beggs resident, passed away on Friday, March 11, 2022 in Tulsa at 86 years of age. He was born Sunday, May 19, 1935 in Beggs to the late Franklin Marion Chambers, Sr. and Lorena May (Massey) Chambers. Wayne graduated from Beggs High School and went to work at the family business, Beggs Feed and Seed. He married Mary Rose Aldridge on May 2, 1953 at the First Baptist Church in Beggs. They moved to Fort Smith where Wayne managed Albert's Feed and Farm Supply, later returning to Beggs where Wayne built several pole barns and was a building consultant. He then found his love for seeing the country while truck driving. After retirement from truck driving, Wayne took up his new hobby of operating a backhoe around their property.

Wayne was known for being a hardworking man and his love for his family. He cherished the time spent with his grandchildren.

Wayne was a member of the First Baptist Church of Beggs.
