Leona "Lee" Lorayne (Lehew) Magrini passed away on Monday, December 2, 2013. She was born in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania on September 25, 1923. She was adopted by Russell and Anna Lehew and raised in Belle Vernon, Pennsylvania where she graduated with the class of 1941.

Lee married Pete Magrini in July of 1942. During his deployment in the war, she worked in Washington, D.C. for the Department of the Navy. They were transferred to Okmulgee in 1950 with the American Window Glass Company. She worked at Phillips Refinery until its closing and retired with the State of Oklahoma in 1989. In Okmulgee, she was active in several clubs including Sesame, PEO, Evergreen Garden Club and the St. Anthony Altar Society. Lee was preceded in death by her parents and husband Pete who passed away in 1992. She is survived by daughter Karen O'Neil and husband Jim of Okmulgee, son Dr. Kent Magrini and wife Tery of Ft.
