



## Leonard Wayne Frazier

April 19, 1948 - September 23, 2012

Funeral services for Leonard Wayne Frazier, 64, of Okmulgee, will be Thursday, September 27, at 2:00 P.M. at First Baptist Church in Okmulgee, Oklahoma. Mr. Frazier was born on April 19, 1948, in Talihina, Oklahoma to Joe and Ruth Frazier. He died on September 23, 2012, in Tulsa, Oklahoma.
