Lucas Ashley "Luke" Holleman was born July 31, 1981 in Okmulgee, Oklahoma to Arthur Lee Holleman, Jr. and Jill (Brian) Holleman. He graduated from Okmulgee High School with the Class of 2000 and was a Valedictorian. He graduated from Oklahoma State University in 2005 with a degree in Finance. Luke worked as a Loan Officer at First National Bank of Okmulgee for several years before joining his father and grandmother in the family business as General Manager at Holleman Iron and Metal. Luke was a two time state champion tennis player in high school. He loved the outdoors, whether he was hiking, camping, target shooting, hunting, fishing or golfing. Luke was a member of St. Anthony of Padua Catholic Church, the Muscogee (Creek) Nation and the Oklahoma Scrap Metal Dealer's Association. He was also involved with United Way Campaign for several years. Luke will be remembered for the way he could make others laugh.

He is preceded in death by his grandparents, James and Shelley Brian and Arthur Holleman, Sr., uncle Buck Brian and nephew Brian Mayfield, Jr.

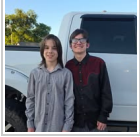

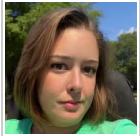

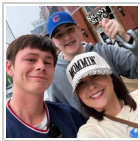
