Lynette Anne Baumann was born Monday, August 1, 1949 in Pender, Nebraska to the late Harold Edward and Lucille (Coan) Elsasser. She passed away surrounded by her loved ones Friday, December 29, 2017 at her Okmulgee residence. She was 68 years of age.

Lynette grew up in Emerson, Nebraska and graduated from Sacred Heart High School in 1967. She then attended Nursing School in Omaha, receiving her L.P.N. Lynette and Walter E. Baumann were married on June 1, 1970 at the Sacred Heart Church in Emerson. They relocated to Del City, Oklahoma while Walt completed his residency and in 1979 made their home Okmulgee. Lynette was very community minded and served in many ways throughout Okmulgee. She remained very active at the Okmulgee County Family YMCA where she taught water aerobics and other exercise classes. She attended classes at OSU-IT in photography, a hobby she enjoyed and took pride in sharing her pictures. Lynette had a great love for the mountains.
