



Margery Buchanan Laub

August 5, 1918 - November 2, 2011

Margery Buchanan Laub died peacefully at home on Wednesday, November 02, 2011. She was 93 years of age. She was born August 5, 1918 in Topeka, Kansas to Dr. Harold Thoes and Allie Dodge Morris. She attended Topeka Public Schools and graduated from Topeka High in 1936. In 1940 she graduated from Kansas State University where she was a member of Kappa Kappa Gamma Sorority and she did her graduate work in commercial dietetic foods at the Women's Educational and Industrial Union, an affiliate of Boston college. During WWII she served as dietician at Menniger's Sanitarium in Topeka, Kansas and also worked as a Dietician at Webster High School in Tulsa. Margery married James Buchanan in December of 1951. Together they owned and worked at the Buchanan Funeral Home and the Rocking Chair Polled Hereford Ranches. She was a member of the First Christian Church for over 50 years. She also belonged to the Chapter ER of PEO, the Evergreen Garden Club, Eastern Star Nettie B. Fair Chapter 241, and the birthday Club. She was preceded in death by her parents as well as her brother Dr. M.D. Morris who died in 2003. Her husband James predated her in death in October of 1978. In September 1984 she married Robert Laub who preceded her in death in 1989.

Margery is survived by nephew Tom Morris and wife Madilyn of Topeka, Kansas, nieces Julie Plourde and husband Allan of Richmond, Virginia, Nancy Cox and husband Clay of Tucson, Arizona, and Anne Cox and husband Tim of Houston, Texas, twelve great nieces and nephews, three great-great

nephews, five great-great nieces, one sister-in-law Jeanne Morris-Johnson, and one grandson Bobby Laub of Guatemala, Mexico.

Services for Margery will be held on Saturday, November 5, 2011 at 2:00 P.M. at the McClendon-Winters Funeral Home Chapel in Okmulgee with Reverend Brian Matthews of the First United Methodist Church of Okmulgee officiating.
