Marilyn Jean (Lewis) Middleton died in Okmulgee on Wednesday, April 20, 2011 at the age of 85. Marilyn was born January 15, 1926 in Okmulgee City Hospital to Grace Jane (Ritchey) and Richard Earl Lewis. She graduated from Morris High School in May of 1943 as Valedictorian of her class. She took a business course at Okmulgee Business College before going to work as bookkeeper at McCracken-Mitchel Hardware in Okmulgee for twelve years, then at the Okmulgee Refinery until September 1982. She married Lawrence Ray Middleton on January 1, 1953 at the First Baptist Church in Morris and they have lived in Morris since that time. Marilyn was a Charter Member of Trinity Baptist Church of Morris. She was saved and then baptized at the First Baptist Church of Morris at the age of thirteen. She was always active, until her illness, as Sunday School Teacher, Church Clerk, and in the music program of these two churches.

Marilyn was preceded in death by her parents, one brother Richard Wayne Lewis, and her parents-in-law William and Pauline Middleton.

Survivors include her husband of 58 years, and one sister Grace Darlene Lewis, both of Morris.

Services will be held on Monday, April 25, 2011 at 2:00 P.M. at the Trinity Baptist Church in Morris with Reverend Richard Kerr officiating. Interment will follow at the Okmulgee Cemetery.
