Marion V. (Drew) Mitchell, longtime Okmulgee resident, died in Okmulgee on Monday, May 23, 2011 at the age of 94. Marion was born in Allue, Oklahoma on October 13, 1916 to John Forrest and Minnie Marie (French) Drew. On January 1, 1935 she married Elton Eugene Mitchell.
