August 15, 1926 - November 9, 2020

Marsalete Ingram passed away on November 9, 2020. There was no one like Marsalete, in person and especially in name. The youngest of seven siblings, her parents created her name by combining her father's, Marshall Lee. Her mother Mollie Cartwright Turner had Marsalete on August 15, 1926 on a farm near Stuart, Oklahoma. Like many Oklahomans during the Depression, the Turners migrated to California for better opportunities. Marsalete spent her teenage years ice skating in San Francisco and picking fruit from street-side trees. She graduated from Oakland High in 1944. Soon after she met and married Billy J.C. Ingram from Calvin, OK in 1945. They enjoyed 52 wonderful years of marriage before Billy passed away in 1997. Marsalete was a secretary in OSU's Diesel Department and member of Okmulgee's Calvary Baptist Church. Marsalete is survived by two sons and spouses: Jimmie and Videlle Ingram of Broken Arrow and Perry and Keiko Ingram of Taiwan; grandchildren and spouses: Warren and Donna Ingram, Dana and Brock Peoples, and Lauren and Sean Reid; dearest of loving friends: Becky Arnold; niece: Carol Roden Tomeck; and great-grandchildren: Paige, Courtney, Grayson, Emma, Ryan, and Eowyn Marsalete.

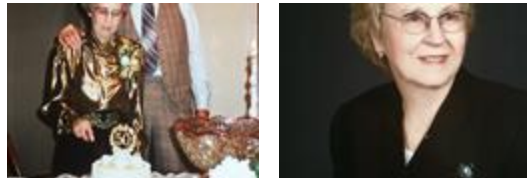
