Mary Lou (McCulloch) Bailey was born Monday, August 4, 1927 in Okmulgee to the late Roy Sterling and Gladys Aleen (Border) McCulloch. She passed away at her home on Thursday, February 5, 2015 at the age of 87. Mary Lou attended the University of Oklahoma and was a member of the Tri Delta Sorority. She married Dick Bailey on February 12, 1950 at the First Christian Church in Okmulgee. Mary Lou had been a longtime member of PEO Chapter Z and the Okmulgee Service League.
