Mary Lou King was born Thursday, May 28, 1936, in Mellette, Oklahoma to the late Lonny and Wynoma (Urquhart) Hopkins. She passed away Wednesday, July 28, 2021, at her home at 85 years of age. Mary was united in marriage to Carl Eugene King on June 3, 1961, in Morris. Her teaching career spanned over thirty years, beginning at Eram and then teaching elementary students at Morris and Jenks. In addition to teaching, Mary and Carl farmed together throughout their marriage. She was an active member of the First United Methodist Church of Morris and cherished the time she spent with her family.

She was preceded in death by her father, Lonny Hopkins, mother, Wynoma Greenhaw, step-father, Turney Greenhaw, a brother, Charles Hopkins and a sister, Hugh Ann Goodacre.
