Mary Ramsey Turner, a long time resident of Okmulgee, went home to be with the Lord Monday, December 20, 2010 at 91 years young.

Mary Kathryn Thomas was born in Stevenson, Alabama on April 19, 1919 and moved to Edna, Oklahoma as a 10 year old girl with her family. There the Thomas family was blended with the Allen family. She was the last of her three brothers and four sisters.

She married Henry Ramsey as a 16 year old girl in 1935 and successfully raised four of six children in the old community of Edna. Two children died from complications early in life. She raised one daughter and three sons; John Ramsey who lives in Antlers, Paul Ramsey and wife Jan of Okmulgee, David Ramsey and wife Sue of Preston and Rosemary Smith of Okmulgee.

She was preceded in death by her husband Henry in 1964. Some years later, she married Sid Turner who also preceded her in death.
