November 14, 1922 - April 28, 2011

Maudie Elizabeth Hartgrave went to be with her Lord on Thursday, April 28, 2011 at the age of 88 years. Elizabeth was born on November 14, 1922 in Clarksville, Arkansas to William Riley and Lillie Pearl (Brock) Kelton. In 1940 she married William Samuel Hartgrave.
