



## Maxine Lee Hinshaw

April 13, 1938 - February 24, 2026

Maxine Lee Hinshaw, 87, of Edmond, Oklahoma, passed away peacefully on February 24, 2026, after a short illness. She was one of six children born to the late Thomas and Sylvie Valerie (Perron) Buxton on April 13, 1938, in Belle Vernon, Pennsylvania.

Maxine graduated from Saint Anthony High School in Okmulgee, Oklahoma. She worked as a beautician in Okmulgee for over 20 years.
