Michael Roy Jordan of Tulsa, Oklahoma, passed away on October 31, 2021, at the age of 74. Mike was born in Russell, Kansas, on January 29, 1947, and was the beloved son of Jess and Bernice (Dunham) Jordan of Tulsa. Throughout his life Mike was a dedicated bibliophile and to the end remained fascinated by new knowledge and ideas and his love of art and the heady joy of finding a real treasure hiding in used books stores throughout eastern Oklahoma.
