



## Mildred Metzger

May 21, 1918 - May 11, 2015

Mildred Harr Metzger, age 96, a long time Okmulgee resident, died peacefully in her sleep in Richmond, VA May 11, 2015. Mildred was born May 21, 1918 in Carrizo Springs, TX to the late Charles Harr and Mary Ingalls. She moved to Okmulgee where she met the love of her life, her husband of 61 years, the late William H. Metzger. She followed him into the service and became an Air Force officer's wife.
