



## Mildred Grace Clements

July 6, 1920 - November 26, 2011

Mildred Grace Clements, longtime Okmulgee resident, died Saturday morning, November 26, 2011 at the Evergreen Care Center in Owasso at the age of 91. She was born July 6, 1920 in Lehigh, Oklahoma. Mildred married Joseph "Clyde" Clements on October 28, 1937 at St. Anthony Catholic Church in Okmulgee. They were married 64 years before his passing on February 24, 2000. Mildred retired from St. John Medical Center in Tulsa as a nurse. She also had worked as a secretary for the Okmulgee Salvation Army and was a longtime member of the United Methodist Church and the Order of the Easter Star, Nettie B. Fair Chapter. She was preceded in death by her parents, Reverend John and Gertrude (Emmons) Foxton. Her husband, two brothers, George Henry Reece and Michael Phillip Reece and a sister, Mary Brown.
