Nancy Lee (Neece) Garrett died peacefully on Monday, July 2nd, 2018, surrounded by family at her home in Broken Arrow, Oklahoma following a long battle with breast cancer. 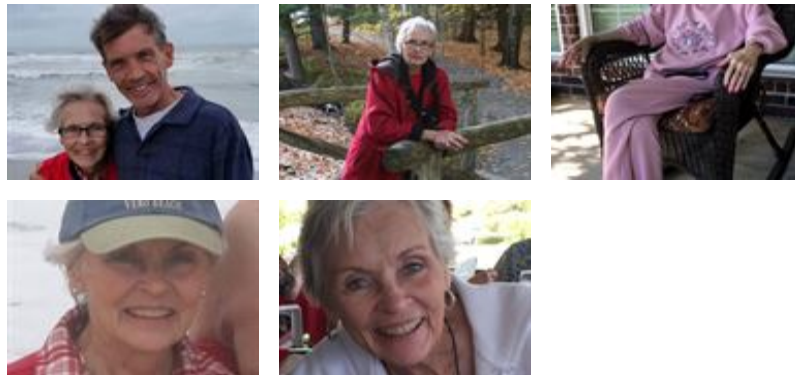
