December 29, 1921 - January 9, 2014

Nona Lucille (Stanley) Cypert was born to Manley Wilson and Almira (Sumner) Stanley on December 29, 1921 in Choctaw, Arkansas. She passed away on Thursday, January 9, 2014 at her home in Nuyaka. Lucille was 92 years of age. Nona Lucille and Glen Dale Cypert were married October 24, 1939 in Okmulgee. She loved making quilts, helping her family and her community. She and her husband donated the land for the Nuyaka Baptist Church and Nuyaka Fire Department. Lucille was a member of the D.A.R. for 32 years, the Home Extension Club, where she received her 50 year pin in 2012, the Nuyaka Baptist Church and Nuyaka School Association.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Glen Dale Cypert in 1997, son, Sherman Theodore (Ted) Cypert, her parents, two sisters, Osa Olivia Stanley and Genevieve Stanley Ledbetter and a brother, Thomas Clinton (T.C.) Stanley.

Survivors include her children, Nona Yvonne Sowder and husband Luther Ray of Okemah, Wilson Riley Cypert and wife Shirley of Wilson, Glenna Kay Ritter and husband Losson of Nuyaka and Myra Dale Gregory of Nuyaka. 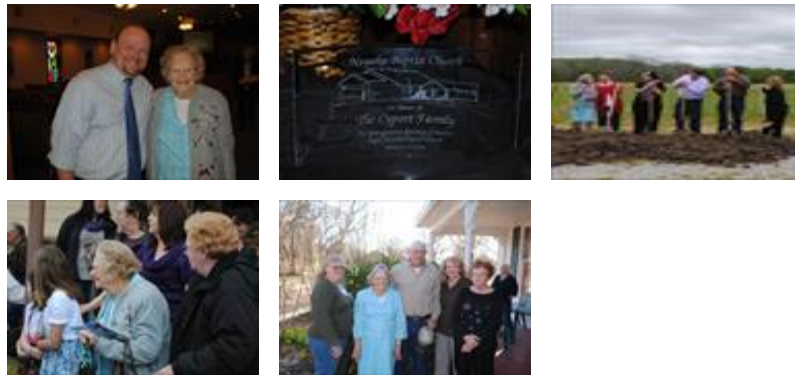
