Paula Sue Mills, 80, longtime Beggs resident, passed away Monday morning May 15, 2017 at her home surrounded by family. She was born September 19, 1936 in Beggs, Oklahoma to the late Frank and Lorena Massey Chambers. She attended Beggs Schools and graduated high school in 1954. She later married Jay Mills on June 24, 1955 in Beggs. Paula worked for the Tulsa City/County Health Department in the Maintenance Department. She enjoyed gardening, sewing, making and selling puppets as well as volunteering as a cook and sponsor at Falls Creek Youth camp in Davis, Oklahoma. 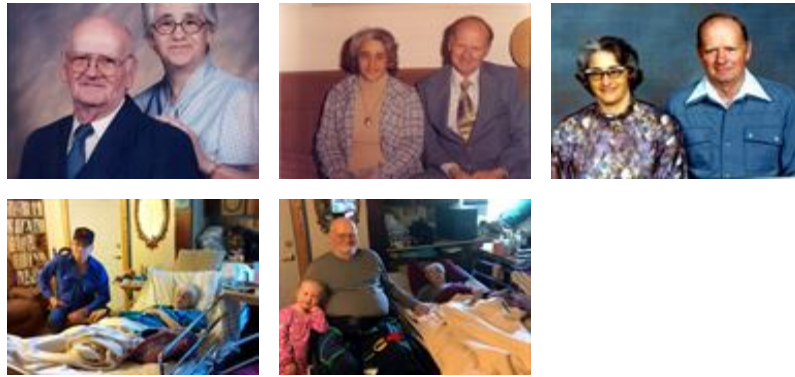
