Pauline Rabbit, 73, went to be with the Lord on Tuesday, February 3, 2016. She was born on January 16, 1943 in Okfuskee County, OK to Walter Jones Sr. and Mary Yahola Jones. She married Amos Rabbit on August 16, 1963. She attended Haskell Indian Nation University, Lawrence, KS. Pauline was a homemaker for many years and she eventually entered the workforce and was a Mechanical Inspector for Varian Medical Systems, Inc. in Palo Alto, California. She was baptized in 1970 at Southern Hill Baptist Church in Hayward, California. She enjoyed playing cards, bingo, dominoes and watching softball and basketball games and loved to read, work crossword puzzles, sewing and quilting, cooking and baking and listening to music.
