Peggy Louise Ellig, a longtime Okmulgee resident, passed away Friday, November 20, 2020 in Tulsa due to complications from Covid-19.

Peggy was born July 22, 1935 in Weleetka. She graduated from Weleetka High School in 1953 and on November 23, 1955 she married Charles Dewayne (Strawberry) Ellig. They would have celebrated their 65th Wedding Anniversary this year. They moved to Okmulgee in 1957. Peggy enjoyed sewing, quilting, reading and cooking. She was a very active member of the Extension Homemakers Club, where she served as past president. She was also involved in the PTA for many years. Peggy helped raise many children in her home daycare and later she was a substitute teacher at Westside School. She was a member of the Wilson Thimble Club and the First Baptist Church of Okmulgee.

Peggy was preceded in death by her parents, Robert Reddick and Lillian (Murray)Donovan and her husband, Dewayne Ellig.

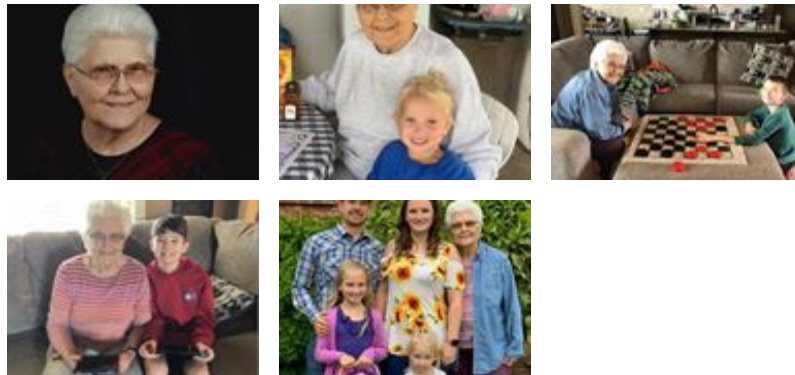
