Raymond Lee Garner 81, longtime resident of Okmulgee, died in Tulsa on Saturday, December 5, 2009. He was born in Preston, Oklahoma on March 9, 1928 to Lum Columbus (L.C.) and Annie Mae (Williams) Garner. He graduated from Preston High School in 1948. Joined the U.S. Marines. He retired from the Merck Corporation. He was married to Shirley Jean Huffman Garner.
