May 30, 1942 - January 6, 2017

Robert Milton “Bob” Coleman, 74, of Henryetta, died Friday, January 6, 2017 at 74 years of age. He was born May 30, 1942 in Hartner, Kansas. He attended High School in Vinita and joined the U.S. Navy in 1961, serving in Albuquerque, New Mexico. Bob then returned to Vinita and worked at an aircraft plant in Coffeyville, Kansas. In 1970, he attended OSU Tech for Air Conditioning and Refrigeration and worked at Montgomery-Ward in repair service for several years. Bob worked for over 30 years as a Campus Police Officer at OSU IT. He loved his law enforcement job, especially helping others. He enjoyed guns, hotrods and Harley Davidson’s. He was preceded in death by his grandparents and great grandparents. Survivors include his son, Jason Coleman and wife Sandra of Afton, granddaughters, Molly, Maggie, Amelia and Emma, his longtime companion and friend, Virginia Carter and her son, Jay Carter and wife Tamara of Marshfield, Missouri, a brother, Don Coleman of Michigan and many friends.
