May 16, 1936 - June 21, 2023

Born to Ethel (Smith) and John Dudley on May 16, 1936, Robert grew up in the Drumright/Cushing area and was nicknamed Bobby Gene. He graduated Cushing High School and attended OSU for a couple of years before joining the Army at 20 years old and traveling the world. In 1959, at just 23 years old, he married the love of his life, Roberta McVay; they were married for 59 years. Robert was a hard worker his entire life, buying, renovating, and selling houses, including several rental properties. He also enjoyed having a cabin on Lake Eufaula, with Roberta, for many years. They had one son, Greg Dudley, and one daughter, Michaëlle. He was preceded in death by both his parents; his sister, Midge; his brother, Tom; his loving wife, Roberta; his son, Greg; and his grandson, Ryan Poff. His survivors include his daughter, one grandson, three granddaughters, and three great grandsons.
