September 16, 1929 - September 5, 2019

Senator Robert Lee (Bob) Miller, 89, of Beggs, died at 7:00 a.m. on September 5, 2019 at his daughter's home in Morris.

He was a lifelong rancher and State Senator for two terms. He was a member of Beggs First Baptist Church. He was an original founder of the Intertribal Agriculture Council and served on the board until his death. He loved his family and friends and loved visiting with everyone. Robert was a great storyteller and had so many great stories to tell.

Robert L. (Bob) Miller was born September 16, 1929, in Okmulgee, Oklahoma. He grew up on the Miller IX Ranch in Okmulgee County. He graduated from High School at Twin Hills, OK and went on to graduate college at Oklahoma A&M. He married his wife, Lydia Jane Rains, on his birthday, September 16, 1952 in Muskogee, Oklahoma. They have two daughters Linda Kathryn Enlow and Lea Ann Nix.

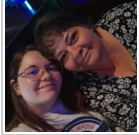

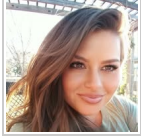
