



Robert Nelson Hahne

December 3, 1939 - April 21, 2011

Robert “Bob” Nelson Hahne, 71, longtime Okmulgee county resident, died Thursday, April 21, 2011 at St. Francis Hospital in Tulsa. He was born December 3, 1939 in Jeannette, Pennsylvania to the late Glenn Hahne, Sr. and Grace (Lower) Hahne. The Hahne family made their home in Oklahoma in late 1953. Bob married Phebe Ann Cunningham on February 27, 1959. He worked at American Saint Gobain as a glass cutter until they closed, then returned to college. He worked for Dresser-Clark in Tulsa and later as a Manufacturing Technology instructor at Oklahoma State University-Okmulgee until his retirement in 2001. Bob was a member of the Society of Manufacturing Engineers and attended the Second Baptist Church. He spent many years helping coach the Beggs Little League teams. He enjoyed hunting, fishing and golfing, and after retirement, Bob and Phebe spent much of their time traveling in their RV. Bob was preceded in death by his parents and a sister, Patty Morris. Survivors include his wife of 52 years, Phebe, a daughter and son-in-law, Christie and Rocky Humphrey of Holly Springs, Mississippi, a son, Darren Hahne of Ottawa, Illinois, brother and sister-in-law, Glenn Hahne, Jr. and Judy Hahne of Okmulgee, brother-in-law and sister-in-law, Ronald and Linda Cunningham of Okmulgee, five grandchildren, Josh Humphrey of Morris, Oklahoma, Ryan Humphrey of Holly Springs, Mississippi, Brittany Hahne and Cody Hahne, both of Fayetteville, Arkansas, and Brendan Hahne of Peru, Illinois and three great grandchildren, Bailey, Braeden and Caylee Humphrey, all of Morris.
