February 4, 1919 - August 15, 2009

Rosalind “Anna Lee Peyton” Burkhalter a longtime resident of Okmulgee, died Saturday, August 15, 2009. Rosalind was born in Okmulgee, Oklahoma on February 4, 1919 to John and Theresa (Edwards) Peyton. She attended Okmulgee schools and graduated from Uganda Martyrs Catholic School.

Rosalind was united in Holy Matrimony to Wadrick Burkhalter October 18, 1947. This union was blessed with one son. She worked as a nurse in doctor’s clinics and St. John Hospital. Later years worked as secretary of the Catholic Community of Okmulgee where she retired. She worked with the Red Cross, and served as Eucharistic Minister to the sick, homebound in nursing homes and hospitals.

Rosalind was a charter member of Alfaretta R. Aubry Ct. Ladies Auxiliary of Knight Peter Claver for 54 years and received many awards. She was a member of Uganda Martyrs Altar Society, Catholic Daughters of America for many years. She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband Warrick P. Burkhalter, a brother, John Anthony Peyton, a grandson James D. Dean.
