Roy Edward Jewett, Jr., a resident of Beggs, passed away Wednesday, October 30, 2019 at the Jack C. Montgomery VA Medical Center in Muskogee. He was 81 years of age. Roy was born February 12, 1938 in Fort Worth, Texas to the late Roy Edward Jewett, Sr. and Dorris (Haley) Jewett. He joined the U.S. Air Force in 1955 and received an honorable discharge in 1960. 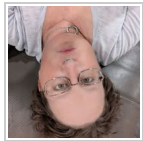
