



Ruth Parker Cobb Baldischwiler

September 6, 1924 - December 2, 2014

Ruth Parker Cobb Baldischwiler, age 90, formerly of Okmulgee, died in Guthrie, Oklahoma, on December 2, 2014. She was born September 6, 1924, in Okmulgee, Oklahoma to John Wilmer and Elizabeth Cobb.

Ruth married Max J. Baldischwiler on December 15, 1948. They had met at Glennan Hospital, where Max was an interpreter with German POW's and Ruth volunteered, during World War II. Their marriage produced four children: Ann, Martha, Max, Jr., and Karl.

Ruth worked at Public Service Company for 23 years, working up from Engineering Clerk to Accounting Manager. She was a life-long member of the First Presbyterian Church in Okmulgee, where she served as Sunday school teacher, Elder, choir member and member of numerous committees. She served on several civic committees, including chairing the United Way campaign. She was a member of P.E.O Chapter ER and Garden Club after retirement.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Max Baldischwiler, her parents, and a sister, Elizabeth Ann Cobb.

Survivors include two daughters: Ann and Husband, Tom Giulioli of Okmulgee, Oklahoma, and Martha and Husband, Tim Rea of Guthrie,

Oklahoma; two sons: Max Baldischwiler, Jr., of Edmond Oklahoma, and Karl and Wife, Rhonda Baldischwiler of Newcastle, Oklahoma. Ruth had 7 grandchildren and 7 great-grandchildren.

Committal service will be held 2:00 P.M., Saturday, December 6, 2014 at the Okmulgee Cemetery with Reverend J. Rodgers Spencer officiating.
