



Ruth Murl Clenney

November 16, 1918 - March 23, 2010

Ruth Murl Clenney died at home on March 23, 2010. She was 91 years of age. Ruth was born in Blackfork, Arkansas on November 16, 1918 to Columbus Harrison and Dora Francis (Johnson) Farmer. She attended Mt. Zion Elementary in Checotah but graduated from Menaul High school in Albuquerque, NM, and attended college at the University of New Mexico. Ruth raised six children. She also worked as an assistant newspaper editor at Estancia; then at Sandia Corp in inventory control; and last as a teacher at a girls' school near Santa Fe. In Davis, Oklahoma she married David Clenney. Ruth enjoyed reading and loved her family.

Ruth was a member of the Morris Assembly of God Church. She was always active in church activities, teaching Sunday School and leading Women's Ministries in Assembly of God Churches. In later years she traveled abroad to Israel, Germany, China, Mexico, the Caribbean and many other countries. She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband David Clenney, a son James Paul Collins, and three brothers Deward, Dewey and Doy Farmer.
