



Sharon Kay Brannon

February 9, 1952 - November 6, 2025

Longtime Okmulgee resident Sharon Kay Brannon passed away on November 6, 2025, at the age of 73. She was born on February 9, 1952, to Raymond and Ruth Ann (Coenen) Smith.

Sharon graduated from Okmulgee High School in 1970. On March 15, 1975, she married Mike Brannon, and together they had two children. The couple recently celebrated their 50th wedding anniversary.

Sharon worked part-time at the OSU-IT Federal Credit Union for 30 years before retiring. She was a longtime member of the Prairie Bell Extension Homemakers Club, where she shared her love of cooking—especially her delicious pies. Sharon was also a devoted member of Trinity Baptist Church of Morris, where she served faithfully on the kitchen committee and helped with the church's sports breakfast program for many years.

She enjoyed hunting, especially for deer, and loved to fish. Above all, Sharon found joy in making her house a home for the family she loved most.

Sharon was preceded in death by her parents; her maternal grandparents, Elmer and Cecil Coenen; and her paternal grandparents, Stanley and Mary Szalankiewicz.
