Sheila Faye Miller died in Tulsa on March 5, 2012 at 69 years of age. Sheila was born in Seattle, Washington on June 30, 1942 to Merrill Massey and Norma (Burgess) Massey-Potter. She attended public and private schools in Seattle where she met her husband while he was serving in the military. On October 21, 1961, in San Diego, California, she married Glenn Miller. Sheila previously was a member of the Catholic Daughter's. Being an intellectual person, she enjoyed watching CNN and other political television shows and she loved to read.

She was preceded in death by her parents and two sisters: Francis Droge and Donna Ghelding.
