January 10, 1933 - April 16, 2022

Stella Louise Davis, longtime Morris resident, passed away Saturday, April 16, 2022 in Tulsa. She was 89 years of age. Stella was born January 10, 1933 in Morris, Oklahoma to the Jake and Leota (Keehn) Reynolds. She married Charles Davis on August 22, 1951 in Morris.

Stella was a member of the Morris High School graduating class of 1951 and was an integral part of seeing that there was an annual class reunion, up until the pandemic stopped the gatherings. Stella loved her community. She was active in the Morris Lioness Club, where she organized the annual Christmas Parade. She put together the Morris History Book and when the new library was built, she spent many years volunteering with Val Volt. 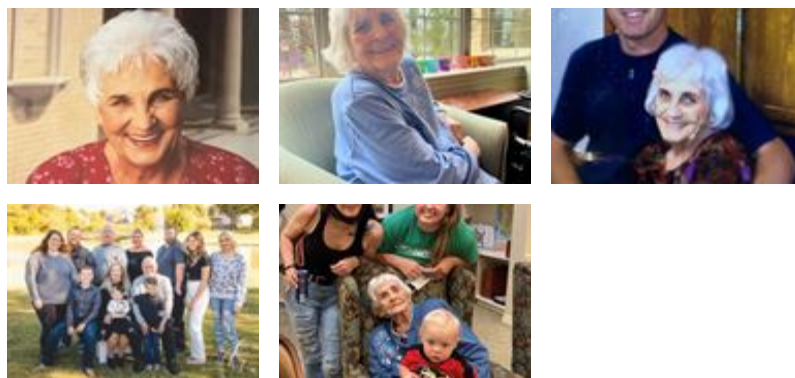
