



## Suda Wise Grayson Taylor

April 28, 1912 - January 26, 2011

Suda was born April 28, 1912 in Hughes Co. OK to Andrew Jackson Stephenson and Jennie Wise (Mullins) Stephenson. Suda was the 8th of 15 children born to Andrew and Jennie.

Suda attended Wilson Elementary and Wilson High School in western Okmulgee County, graduating with honors and she was the captain of the Wilson girls' basketball team. She married Jeff Taylor July 4, 1931. Jeff also went to Wilson, graduated with honors, and he was the captain of the boys' basketball team.

Jeff and Suda established their first household north of Henryetta where Carol was born. They moved from there to the Gypsy Hill area northwest of Wilson School where Jeff was an oil field pumper and farmer. Donald and Michael were born while they lived at Gypsy Hill. In 1943 they moved to the Rocky Hill area west of Okmulgee. Jeff and Suda farmed, ran a dairy, and ranched in this area until 1964. Jeff and Suda's last home was on North Oklahoma Street on the northwest side of Okmulgee. Suda moved to North Crutchmer Street in 1975 after Jeff passed away.

Suda married Jeff Conway in 1980 and Marshall Grayson in 1987. Suda and Marshall resided at the North Crutchmer address when Marshall passed away in 1991.

In 1995 Suda moved to Lake Havasu City, AZ to live with her daughter Carol and her son-in-law Hank Carnell. Suda moved to Elephant Butte NM in 2006 at which time Suda became a resident of the Sierra Hill Assisted Living Center

in Truth or Consequences NM. Suda and Carol both passed away at the Sierra Home Health Center; Carol on December 11, 2010 of cancer and Suda on January 26, 2011.

Suda was preceded in death by her husbands, 13 brothers and sisters, and her daughter Carol and son Donald. She is survived by her sister Dorothy Pace of Turlock CA, son Mike of Katy TX, 8 grandchildren, and 15 great grandchildren. She will be greatly missed. A private committal service was held at the Okmulgee Cemetery. A date for her memorial service will be announced in the spring. Arrangements are under the direction of the McClendon-Winters Funeral Home of Okmulgee.
