



## Terry Lee Cotner

January 19, 1953 - March 13, 2022

Terry Lee Cotner, 69 year old Sapulpa resident, passed away Sunday, March 13, 2022 at his home. Terry was born January 19, 1953 in Okmulgee to the late Walter G. “Dub” Cotner and Pauline (Sturgis) Cotner. He was raised in Okmulgee and graduated from Okmulgee High School in 1971. He was involved in the Drama Club, Boy Scouts, Band and athletics while in high school.

Terry resided in Okmulgee, Mounds and Tulsa before relocating to Santa Fe, New Mexico. He later returned to Oklahoma and made Sapulpa his home. Terry was a carpenter and worked for Oklahoma Fixture Company and Zigler’s. He enjoyed listening to music, playing his guitar and being outdoors, especially camping and building campfires. 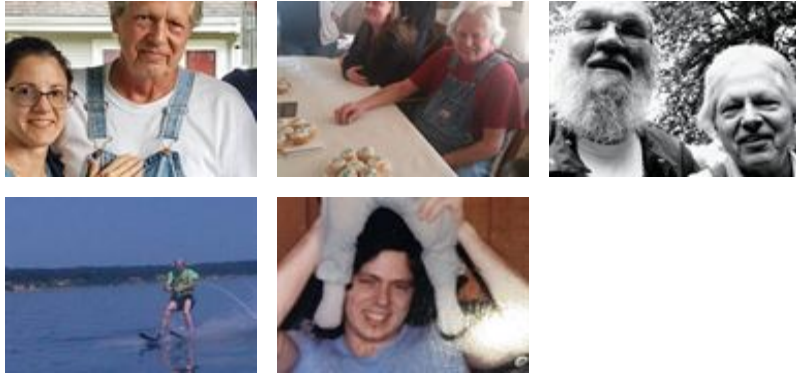
