Virginia Mae (Jones) Beesley Ash was born Thursday, July 23, 1936 in Okmulgee to the late Robert Allen and Essie Faye (Reynolds) Jones. She passed away Saturday, November 14, 2020 in Tulsa at 84 years of age. She attended Oakdale School, graduating in 1954. 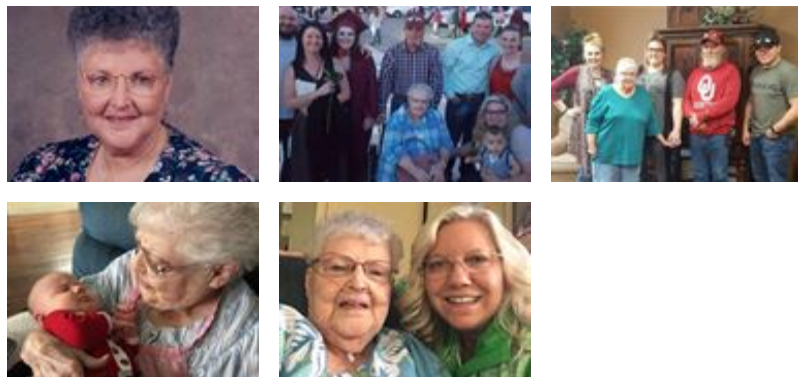
