Vivian Ann Lowery, 83, a resident of Creek County, Oklahoma, died on Tuesday, December 21, 2010. She was born in Okmulgee, Oklahoma to Joseph Albert and Telitha Elzina (Luna) Thornburgh, on July 14, 1927.
